Lion Leonard moved to accept the treasurer's report and Lion Shawn seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The club received correspondence from Foundation Fighting Blindness thanking the club for our recent donation and from Lion Jess Gavez regarding funding needs for Camp Lions.

Old Business

Members tabled discussion until next month on whether to add to our club's donation to fund the middle school projector project in order to give Lee and Shabbona Lions Clubs a chance to report their actions concerning the project.

Lions Leonard led discussion on plans for Lions Summerfest and Antique Tractor and Truck Show.

Lions Dave reported that volunteers for the Fishing Derby should arrive at the lake by 10 a.m. on Thursday. Our club will serve a pork chop dinner at 6 p.m. that evening.
